## **RULES AND INFORMATION FOR ALL COMPETITIONS**

Tables and back screens will be draped in green cloth.

Backboards are NOT allowed with your exhibit.

Only tags/labels supplied to be used on the item or display and no identification of either entrant(s) or WI.

All entries must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor(s) and must have been made and/or designed within the last 12 months. Worn, used or soiled items must NOT be entered.

The judges' decision will be final.

The hall will close at 12 noon prompt for judging.

All flowers / floral exhibits to be brought pre-arranged.

The Board of Trustees cannot accept responsibility for any items entered and suggest that any valuable items be adequately insured by the exhibitor.

The Board of Trustees will NOT be responsible for items not collected at the shown time.

Bins will be provided for the disposal of unwanted food items and any food not in a jar will be disposed of if not collected by the time stated.

Fees are stated on the individual entry forms.

Check that your entry complies with the rules and information.

### **CLOSING DATE FOR ALL ENTRIES: Friday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021**

**Setting up:** Will be between 11am & 12noon on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Please do not attempt to enter the building before 11am and you must aim to leave as soon as possible but definitely by 12noon to allow preparation time for the stewards.

**Viewing:** In order for members to look around all the entries, Derbyshire House will be open from 12noon on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October.

**Collection:** In order to leave the exhibits in situ for others to enjoy, you will NOT be allowed to remove your item/display before 3pm on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021, unless there are exceptional circumstances (if so, please ask to speak to the person in charge in advance).

**Open Class competitions:** Entries should be handed in at the reception table at Derbyshire House on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021. We will place them ready for judging and display them afterwards. A maximum of one item per class per person.

**Co-operative competitions:** At least four members should be involved with a craft or home economics entry and at least two members with a White Peak entry. Entries should be staged at Derbyshire House and collected as shown above. Only two people should work on the staging and entry. Remember that ALL items have to be easily removable from the display for judging. Recipes (ingredients and method) should be placed in an envelope and left just under the edge of your display.

**Craft items:** Please state on tags whether original design, counted thread or kit.

**Home Economics items:** Do not use items which could give risk of food poisoning i.e. food which may contain perishable ingredients that deteriorate easily if not refrigerated, such as pate, fish, cream, rice, raw eggs and yogurt.

#### RECIPE FOR CARROT CAKE

##### **Ingredients:**

200g grated carrot, 3 large eggs, 100ml sunflower oil, 200g self-raising flour, 100g sultanas, 100g light brown sugar, grated zest of ½ an orange, 90g chopped pecan nuts, 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon, ½ teaspoon grated nutmeg, 1½ teaspoons baking powder. Topping: 90g softened butter, 60g cream cheese and 120g sieved icing sugar – all mixed together until smooth and spreadable.

Preheat oven to 180°C (fan assisted). You will need an 8"/20cm round tin, with a loose base and lined with baking parchment.

##### **Method:**

1. In a large bowl, beat the eggs. Add the oil and sugar and whisk until well combined.
2. Stir in the grated carrot, followed by the sultanas, orange zest and nuts (if using).
3. Sieve the spices, baking powder and flour and add to the carrot mixture. Stir in the ingredients without beating.
4. Pour into the prepared tin, level out the mixture, place in the oven and cook for approx. 40-45mins or until cooked.
5. Leave to cool for 5mins before removing from cake tin, remove lining paper and allow to cool completely.
6. When cold, spread the topping on the cake.

#### RECIPE FOR HOMITY PIE

##### **Ingredients:**

Pastry case – 6oz/150g self-raising flour, 3oz/75g fat (vegetarian fat may be used).

Filling – 8 potatoes baked in their skins (you can use the microwave), 3 cloves garlic, 1lb/400g onions, 3tbsp olive oil, 5tbsp chives (or any herb), 8oz/200g grated cheese (vegetarian cheese may be used), salt and pepper.

##### **Method:**

1. Preheat the oven to 220°C/425°F/Gas Mark 4.
2. Grease the dish. Place the flour in a basin and rub in the fat until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs. Add sufficient water to make a soft dough. Roll out and line the flan dish.
3. Scoop out the potatoes from their jackets and roughly chop. Chop the onions and sauté with the garlic in the olive oil until soft.
4. Combine the potatoes, onion, 4tbsp of chives (or other herb), 4oz cheese and season well. Fill the pastry case and sprinkle with the remaining cheese.
5. Bake in the oven for 40 minutes or until golden brown. Sprinkle with the remaining herbs.
